Purchase a brick paver stone that will be on display in the garden and add your own personal message to it. The first set of bricks will be placed in the southwest corner of the backyard garden. The bricks will be installed this summer. (We may open up further parts of the garden in future years.)

What a great way to acknowledge someone special with this permanent historic marker! You could use your brick paver stone to:

- honor friends and family or as gifts for grandparents and children
- remember loved ones
- promote business and community organizations
- commemorate special occasions.

Your personalized brick will be on view for house and museum visitors right outside Chicago's oldest home.

Choose your own text and message:

- \$125 4x8 inch brick maximum 3 lines with 13 characters per line
- \$250 8x8 inch brick maximum 6 lines with 13 characters per line
- \$500 12x12 inch brick maximum 9 lines with 18 characters per line, or special inscription and logos
