NORWOOD PARK HISTORICAL SOCIETY RESUMES LINE DANCING CLASSES:

SESSIONS WILL BE HELD ON APRIL 15, MAY 13 AND JUNE 10

Mark your calendars—line dancing classes to country and/or western music are back. The Norwood Park Historical Society is scheduling three sessions of line dancing classes, beginning on April 15 and continuing on May 13 and June 10. Classes will be held for persons 18 years of age or older from 7 p.m. – 8 p.m., in the Noble Room, at the historic Noble-Seymour-Crippen House (Chicago’s oldest), 5624 N. Newark Ave.

All levels of dancers are welcome, song requests are accepted, and participants must wear soft soled shoes so as not to mar the floor. Classes are free, but a \$5 donation to the Norwood Park Historical Society will be greatly appreciated. Limited parking is available behind the building. Classes will be taught by Cheryl Kelly, a member of the organization who has conducted line dancing classes for the past several years at the NSC House and at the Norwood Park Senior Center.
